











Information for Active and Observer Participants

Thank you for applying for the Sandbox Sessions. We are really looking forward to meeting you at your workshop in January! Here is some useful information to help you prepare, and find the sessions!

Repertoire & Score Preparation:

The repertoire for your workshop will be the 1st & 2nd movement of Mozart *Eine kleine Nachtmusik* and the 1st & 2nd movement of Warlock's *Capriol Suite*. Choose your favourite 1st movement to prepare in detail, then choose the second movement from the other piece! For example, choose the 1st movement of the Mozart, and then the 2nd movement of the Warlock OR, the 1st movement of the Warlock and the 2nd movement of the Mozart. **Download your scores, more detailed instructions, as well as tips on score preparation from www.iverniaarts.com**

We encourage observer participants to prepare their scores as thoroughly as possible to get the most from the session!

Workshop Schedule for Athenry (8th January) & Limerick (15th January)

11:45am Arrival & Registration (payment of €20 fee for active participants)

12:00 - 1:30pm: Group lesson on the basics of conducting (active & observer participants)

- What does a conductor do?
- How to move your hands to convey the information the players need?
- A look at the repertoire you have been preparing.

1:30 - 2:00pm: Break

- Bring along your own lunch if you like.
- The closest shops are a 10 minute drive from the venue.

2:00 - 4:00pm: Conducting session with string quartet (only active participants will conduct the string quartet, but passive participants should stay to observe and learn from their colleagues)

- Your chance to try out your skills as a conductor with a professional string quartet guided by conductor Sinead Hayes.
- You will have at least 10 minutes of guided conducting time with the quartet.
- The first person up gets a bonus 5 minutes extra at the end bravery is rewarded!
